

GRAFFITI REMOVAL FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY

The Graffiti Removal Policy were adopted by Full Council at its Meeting held on 5 September 2017.

Parishioners wishing to request graffiti removal from their property should contact Hazlemere Parish Council to obtain the relevant graffiti removal form.

A consent form needs to be signed, as some of the processes used may occasionally cause damage to the surface.

Mild solvent and high pressure hose may be used. Graffiti on painted surfaces may not be able to be removed as the treatment process may cause too much damage. We recommend that graffiti on such surfaces is painted out by the owner of the property.

Small jobs are usually undertaken free of charge however bigger jobs may be chargeable.

Please provide photographic evidence of any work needed to be undertaken.
