

Noticeboard Policy

The Noticeboard Policy was adopted by Full Council at its Meeting held on 1 December 2015.

The following guidelines have been agreed by Council:

1. Parish Council notices take precedent over any other notices.
2. Priority is then given to events or organisations which are local Parish charities and non-profit making events.
3. No party political notices or advertisements are permitted.
4. The consent of the Council for the notices shall be sought beforehand, and if prior permission has not been sought posters shall be removed.
5. Strictly no notices may be displayed on street furniture.
6. Notices to be put up no more than one week in advance of the event and removed immediately after the event has taken place.
7. The Parish Clerk, after consultation with the Chairman, is given delegated powers to grant permission for those events deemed by them to be within the acceptable criteria.
8. The Council continues to remove unauthorised signs from its property.
