

Advertising Policy

The Advertising Policy was adopted by Full Council at its Meeting held on 1 December 2015.

1. Any advertising on Council property may only be displayed with written authority from Hazlemere Parish Council, although generally permission will not be given to advertising benefiting business or private interests.
2. Advertising must be for information pertinent to the community, or in support of community events.
3. Adverts are not to be displayed for any more than 21 days and must be removed within 2 days following an event.
4. The period of display is to be agreed with Hazlemere Parish Council.
5. Adverts must be in keeping with the area.
6. No obscene or offensive language or images are to be used.
7. Specific siting for the advertising will be outlined in the permission.
8. No political adverts are permitted.
9. Adverts on Parish Council bus shelters are dealt with under a separate contract.

This policy is to be enforced by the Council. Any advertising found without written permission will be removed.

Consent from Hazlemere Parish Council does not imply that a planning consent from Wycombe District Council would be granted for the advertising media being used.
